

FOX KNOLL Homebuilder Green Energy Credit

What is it?

• \$7,500.00 cash rebate towards the installation of a solar or other alternative residential energy generation system that in aggregate provides a minimum 50% of the standard daily energy needs of an average single-family home in the Alliant Energy or Madison Gas and Electric service area.

Which Lots does the Credit apply to?

• The Green Energy Credit applies only to the following Lots within the Fox Knoll subdivsion: #37, #38, #39, #40, #41, #42, #43, #44, #45, #46, #47, #48, #49, #51, #52 #53, #54, #55, #58, #59, #60, #61, #62, #63, #64, #65, #66, #67, #70, #71, #72 & #73.

How does it work?

- Submit documentation from a contractor detailing that the proposed alternative energy system(s) meets the requirements of the program, and the total installation costs associated with such system(s) to the Architectural Review Committee and The City of Madison Building Inspection Division. This information must be submitted to the City of Madison with the initial construction permit application.
- After the documentation has been reviewed and approved by both entities (Architectural Review Committee and The City of Madison Building Inspection Division), and installation of the system is completed, a rebate will be issued to the applicant.
